
Help Build the New PRWC Education Center!

Each year, Peace River Wildlife Center rescues and cares for over 2,500 injured, orphaned, or displaced native Florida wildlife. While our goal is always to rehabilitate and release them, some become permanent residents, helping to educate the public about local wildlife.

With Charlotte County's growth, rescues continue to rise. To meet this demand, we are building a state-of-the-art education center on Henry Street near downtown Punta Gorda. This four-acre site will provide more space for wildlife exhibits, interactive displays, public programs, and upgraded animal care areas.

The project will cost approximately \$6 million. As Charlotte County's only wildlife rehabilitation center and a key educational resource in Southwest Florida, we are committed to protecting wildlife and inspiring our community.


